THE HOLY SPIRIT AND YOUR MINISTRY

The entire grounding for proper NT ministry begins in the book of Acts. It is where the ministry of the NT church begins, grows, and is defined. It is here, more than in any other resource, we discover the foundations of proper ministry. It is here we discover the need for the operation of the Holy Spirit in our personal lives and churches if we hope to please Him and have success.

Acts 1:1 (NKJV)

1 The former account I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach.

What Jesus did was a BEGINNING...

What the Holy Spirit wants to do is RIGHT NOW...

Hebrews 3:7 (NKJV)

7 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, if you will hear His voice.

Focus on PRACTICING THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT in your current and future ministry settings.

I. MAKING ROOM IN YOUR MINISTRY FOR THE MANIFESTATION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

1 Corinthians 1:7 (NKJV)

7 so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 12:31 (NKJV)

31 But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way.

Paul pointed out 2 areas of eagerness for the Corinthians...and us...

- Return of Jesus
- Release of Holy Spirit Gifts until that occurs

"EARNESTLY" (Second Person Present Tense Plural Imperative Subjunctive) What in the world does that mean?

- You...personally
- You...collectively
- Do...command
- Possible...everyone has the potential
- Now...never changes
- YOU MUST STRIVE TO MAKE ROOM IN YOUR LIFE, AND THE CHURCH WHERE YOU SERVE, CONTINUALLY, FOR THE MANIFESTATION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT!



FLOW...the ability to flow with the waves of the Holy Spirit is essential. Unfortunately, there is no biblical guideline that is put forth in an easy to read fashion. It is more ART than SCIENCE, but must be learned.

How do I learn to FLOW with the Spirit: AWARE...ASK..ACT!

II. MAKING ROOM IN YOUR MINISTRY FOR MANIFESTATIONS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

The manifestations are too numerous to fully cover here. You need to spend time and money investing in your study in this field. In theology it is called "Pneumatology," and you will never fully exhaust the massive work. But you do need to dig deep.

The Spirit is shown in scripture as manifesting in the following manner...

John 16:8-14 Conviction of sin, righteous living, coming judgment 1 Corinthians 12 The bestowal of supernatural gifts Romans 12:6-8 Enhancement of gifts which naturally occur

Make up your mind now: 1 Corinthians 14:40

III. MANAGING SPIRITUAL MANIFESTATIONS IN YOUR MINISTRY

This is not "control," but "oversight."

Why is this necessary?

Some will be devoid of guile, but over exuberant. Some will be devilish and guilty of overt evil. YOU will be in the position of managing these situations.

- i. Build everything on ancient foundations (Proverbs 22:28)
 - a. Build ministry on the Word
 - b. Boldly proclaim Jesus as the answer
 - c. Be courageous in the two off-limits words (Acts 2:38)
- Base every manifestation on the ancient boundary ii.
 - a. Stop some
 - b. Stretch others
 - c. Speak truth to all
- iii. Be diverse in acceptance and allowance for spiritual manifestations (1 Corinthians 12:11, Acts 1:14)
